

## **Information on the processing of personal data according to art. 13 of the GDPR 2016/679 (General Data Protection Regulation, European regulation on the protection of personal data)**

According to Article 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation no. 2016/679 (hereinafter, "GDPR"), Fondazione Hub Innovazione Trentino, with registered office in Trento, Piazza Mancini n. 17 (hereinafter, "HIT"), as **Data Controller**, herein provides information on the processing of personal data of persons who, through the appropriate form, register for the event "PROTO Challenge", pursuant to the public selection notice of 23/11/2023.

The processing of personal data is based on principles of correctness, lawfulness and transparency. Personal data are collected for specific, explicit and legitimate purposes and are also adequate, relevant and limited to what is necessary with respect to the purpose for which they are collected and processed.

Personal data will be updated periodically in accordance with the purposes for which they are processed, and they will be stored in such a way as to allow the identification of data subjects for a period of time not exceeding the achievement of the purposes for which the data are processed and in such a way as to guarantee adequate security.

### **1. Data Controller and Data Protection Officer**

### **1. Purpose of the processing, mandatory conferment and legal basis**

The personal data you provide – as identified or identifiable individual – are processed by HIT to carry out the procedure related to the abovementioned selection notice and, in particular, for the purpose of (i) managing the organization of the event; (ii) complying with any contractual obligation deriving or connected thereto; (iii) fulfilling any obligation deriving from national and European legislation.

In accordance with such purposes, HIT will exclusively process personal data such as name and last name, address, and contact numbers.

Subject to specific and optional consent, HIT will process your Data to send communications related to the future edition of the event or similar events (newsletter).

There is no obligation to provide your Data, however, without them it won't be possible to participate to the event.

The legal basis for the processing of personal data are:

1. The legitimate interests pursued by the Data Controller for the management of the event;
2. Processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract;
3. Processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject;
4. (optional) the consent of Data Subject to the processing of his or her personal data for marketing purposes (newsletter).

## **2. Processing methods, automated decision-making processes and data retention times**

The processing of your personal data is carried out by means of information technologies, although potential processing in paper form are not excluded. Personal data are processed using appropriate measures to guarantee confidentiality, prevent loss, illicit and incorrect use and prevent access by unauthorized third parties.

No automated decision-making processes are used to process your personal data.

Your personal data, collected through the registration form, will be stored for the time necessary to fulfill the purposes listed above, or – when it is given – until the withdrawn of consent.

HIT will comply with any legislation requiring longer retention time.

## **3. Communication, location of servers, dissemination and transfer of data to third countries or international organizations**

In order to manage the event, HIT might need to avail itself of third parties with whom it collaborates and which can be identified as Data Controller or Data Processor. Such third parties might be consultants, professionals and partners of the event, as well as service providers supporting the management and maintenance of the infrastructure that allows the registration and management of the event. Should it be necessary, personal data might be communicated to public entities at local, national and/or European level.

Your personal data will be stored on servers located within the European Union or managed by companies that comply with the Privacy Shield requirements, guaranteeing a process of personal data in line with European security standards.

Your personal data will not be transferred to third countries or international organizations outside the EU.

To ensure transparency during award procedures, Data can be published in compliance with transparency obligations ex. Art. 15 D.Lgs. 33/2013.

#### **4. Rights of the interested party and complaint to the Privacy Guarantor.**

You have the right to request us at any time access to your personal data, their modification, integration or deletion, and to limit or oppose their processing for legitimate reasons, as well as their transfer to another Data Controller. Written response will be provided within 30 days.

Should you considered that your personal data are illegitimately processed, you can also submit a complaint with the National Supervisory Authority.
